

Examples of Reasonable Accommodations:

In the application process:

- ◆ Sending an application in the mail to someone when the procedure is ‘apply-in-person’
- ◆ Allowing someone to assist the client in filling out the application

For a lease:

- ◆ Allowing service animals or companion animals when the building has a “no pets” policy
- ◆ If based on one’s disability the resident has a difficult time remembering dates and times, a reasonable accommodation request could be made for a 3rd party to deliver the rent payment to the rental office
- ◆ If a person is receiving social security disability and they receive their check on the 5th of each month but rent is due on the 1st, then a reasonable accommodation request could be made that the provider collect the rent on the 5th instead of the 1st of each month
- ◆ Providing an accessible parking space

Examples of Reasonable Modifications:

- ◆ Installing smoke detectors with strobe flashers in a unit for someone that is hard of hearing
- ◆ Installing a ramp
- ◆ Installing grab bars within a bathroom
- ◆ Making doors and hallways wider
