## ADDICTION & RECOVERY


 **Joelyn's Family Home**  
*Boston's Long Island*  
*Intake: 617-456-1201, x102*  
A 4-8 month residential treatment program for 47 women addressing substance use disorders.

 **Portis Family Home**  
*Jamaica Plain*  
*Intake: 617-522-3089*  
A residential shelter with recovery support services for homeless women and their children, housing up to eight families.


 **Victory House**  
*South End*  
*Intake: 617-825-6088, x514*  
A 4-8 month residential treatment program for 24 men with substance use disorders who may also be dealing with mental health issues and chronic illness.


 **New Victories**  
*Dorchester*  
*Intake: 617-825-6088, x514*  
A 4-8 month residential treatment program for men diagnosed with substance use disorders who may also be dealing with HIV/AIDS, mental health issues or head injuries.


 **Shepherd House**  
*Dorchester*  
*Intake: 617-456-1201, x102*  
A 4-8 month residential treatment program for 32 women with substance use disorders that provides a bridge between treatment and re-integration into community living.


 **Women's Hope**  
*Jamaica Plain*  
*Intake: 617-442-0048 x300*  
A 14-28 day specialized treatment program at the Lemuel Shattuck Hospital for 28 women addressing substance use disorders who may also be living with chronic or mental health issues.

## HIV/AIDS

 **Boston Living Center**  
*Back Bay*  
*Membership: 617-236-1012*  
A non-residential community and resource center for men and women living with HIV/AIDS that provides meals, support groups and other resources free of charge Monday-Friday to its 1,300 members.

 **Living & Recovering Community (LARC)**  
*Jamaica Plain*  
*Intake: 617-522-2936*  
A 90-day stabilization program at the Lemuel Shattuck Hospital for 20 men and women living with HIV/AIDS, recovering from substance use disorders and who have a history of chronic relapse.

 **Victory Transitional House**  
*Dorchester*  
*Intake: 617-282-1984*  
A transitional housing program for six men living with HIV/AIDS who may also be dealing with mental health and substance use issues.

 **Women's Hope Transitional House**  
*Dorchester*  
*Intake: 617-442-7800*  
A transitional housing program for seven women living with HIV/AIDS who may also be dealing with chronic substance use issues.

Victory Programs operates 19 health and housing programs in Boston, Cambridge and Topsfield including several permanent housing programs not included here.
