#### Goals:

Any promotional material will go beyond "get tested get cured" by directing people to our website with a listing of providers offering care to those actively using or in treatment for substance use disorder.

- Still need to finalize content and design of the poster. Plan to use imagery reflecting the target population, focusing on the accessibility of and coverage for treatment.
- Consider alternative routes for spreading the message, e.g. T-shirts to be worn on subway and bicycle rides and by street musicians and vendors.
- Integrate lists of community organizations, clinics, recovery programs, and meeting sites for outreach over availability of testing and treatment and for offering our provider list.
- Coordinate efforts with www.help4hep.org which provides a comprehensive website including links to the CDC as well as a confidential M-F toll-free help line: 877-Help-4-Hep (877-435-7443).

### **Spare Change Newspaper:**

- The Coalition will submit a listing for the "Helping Hands" section of Spare Change showing our website with provider list and directing readers to the toll free helpline (above).
- Committee members will look to other free newspapers read by our target population.

- We will write and submit a letter to the editor of Spare Change News and any other identified publications.
- Rich will draft and forward to committee for ideas and edits
