The safety of our community is of vital importance to Victory Programs. This is why we have developed the following protocols to help keep each other safe during this time.

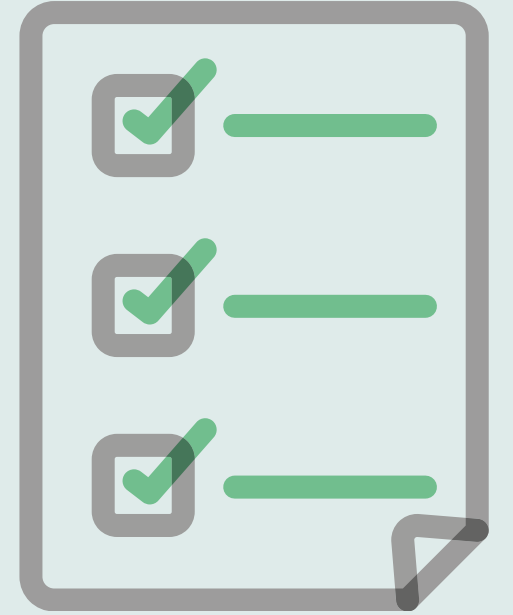
Volunteer Waiver

Prior to start of your first shift you must complete a waiver.



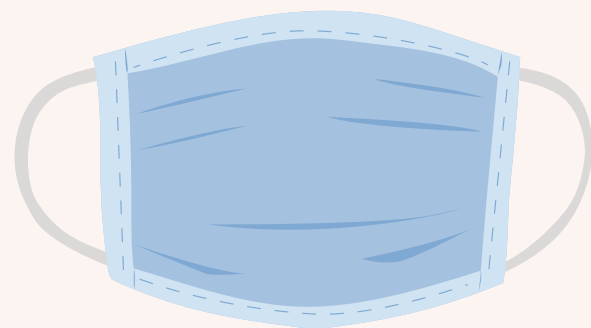
COVID 19 Screening

Complete a COVID-19 Screening form upon arriving onsite. This will ensure you will be authorized to be on site.



Face coverings are required

Everyone is required to wear masks or face coverings to volunteer. If you do not have a face covering, one will be provided to you.



Sick = Stay Home

If you or someone in your household is unwell, please keep everyone safe and stay home.



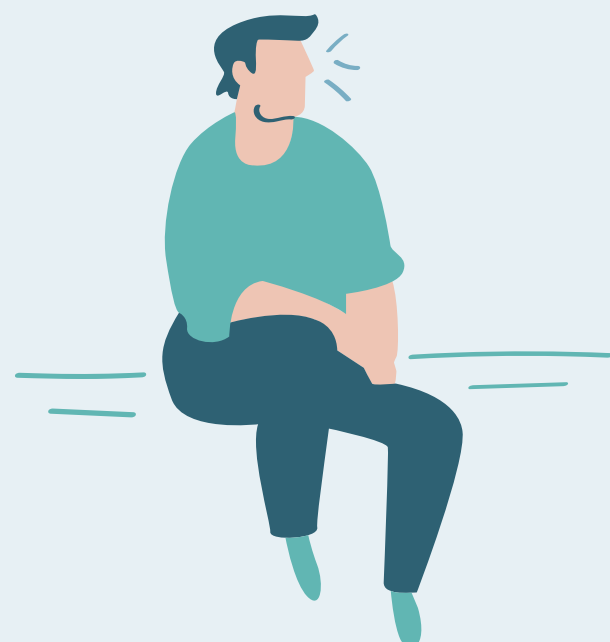
Wash your hands

Practice good hand hygiene by washing your hands with soap and water or using alcohol hand sanitizer before, during and after your volunteer shift.



Practice social distancing

Maintain at least 6 feet distance from others when possible. Always greet without physical contact.



No personal items

Personal items such as cellphone, keys, wallet, etc. must not be used during your shift. A secure location will be provided for storage. If an item is used your hands MUST be re-washed and/or gloves must be changed.
