446 individuals sought refuge at the Victory Connector.



108 individuals transitioned from shelter into safe, stable, and permanent supportive housing.



342 adults and children were served at our emergency family shelters.



617 individuals received critical services and support at one of our six residential recovery homes – an increase of 10% from last year.



159 HIV+ heads of household and their 141 household members received support to maintain housing and access to utilities through our new Rental Assistance Program.



1,046 turned to the BLC for nourishment, connection, and guidance – an increase of 14% from last year.



39,693 meals were served at the Boston Living Center – an increase of 587 meals over the last year.



104 new hires stepped into roles across Victory Programs.



345 hard-working individuals made up the Victory Programs workforce.
